2020 MIACCA HIGHLIGHTS

- Keeping our members informed of COVID-19 industry related updates, resources and requirements
- Urged Governor to classify HVACR businesses as essential to keep you working through COVID-19
- Pushed for the appointment of the new Energy Ombudsman
- Endorsed appointment of the new Michigan Public Service Commissioner
- MIACCA's comments adopted by the MPSC for annual utility value added products and service (VAPS) reports to be made public, in accordance with the Code of Conduct.
- Annual VAPS reports for DTE, Consumers Energy and other utilities readily available only at MIACCA.ORG.
- Convince LARA Director and the Construction Codes Commission to acknowledge that state law allows the commission to approve permit forms. Working with commission to adopt statewide mechanical permit
- Worked with Senator Victory to introduce and pass through the Senate SB-827 that will allow:
 - Employer verified mechanical work experience*
 - Allow existing mechanical contractors to expand their license classifications*
 - Provide for reasonable work experience credit for HVAC college or approved apprenticeship*
- Advocating to keep the exemption of not having sealed drawings required for new residential homes
